SAILING ROUTE 2

DAY 1	SATURDAY	DRVENIK MALI
Marina Baotić 	Trogir 	Vela Rina Bay 

Start: Start your sailing vacation from the **MK Yacht Explorer base in Marina Baotić (Trogir)** on Saturday after 17:00.

Sail / Anchor: A short and easy evening sail towards **Vela Rina Bay (Drvenik Mali Island)**. Instead of heading straight to a busy town, the first night is spent in nature – calm and quiet.

Swim: Evening swim in crystal-clear waters, often completely alone in the bay.

Dinner: Dinner on board at sunset.

Atmosphere: A perfect way to disconnect after arrival – stars above, gentle sounds of the sea, and total tranquility.


DAY 2	SUNDAY	KANICA BAY
Stivašnica Bay 	Kanica Bay 	Ražanj 

Sail / Anchor: Short sail to *Kanica Bay* in the morning or to *Stivašnica Bay*, perfect for relaxed anchoring.

Swim: Turquoise waters ideal for swimming, SUP, and snorkeling, with very little boat traffic.

What to do: Snorkeling along the rocks, lunch on board, and a true “slow sailing” afternoon. Visiting lavender labyrinth.

Optional lunch: *Konoba Kanica* for an authentic, family-run dining experience.

DAY 3	MONDAY	ROGOZNICA
Marina Frapa 	Dragon's eye 	Cape Planka 

Sail / Anchor: Morning sail to Rogoznica, with a berth in *Marina Frapa* or anchoring just outside the old town.


What to do: A relaxed walk through the old village and visit the *Dragon's Eye Lake* (*Zmajevo Oko*).

Swim: Swimming near *Cape Planka* (*Puntaplanka*), the most prominent point of the Croatian mainland coast, where sea currents and winds meet.

Dinner: *Lanterna* or *Siesta* Restaurant – excellent seafood, local olive oil, and fresh Dalmatian ingredients.

Evening vibe: Calm and elegant – Rogoznica evenings are peaceful and charming.

DAY 4	TUESDAY	PRIMOŠTEN
Marina Kremik	Primošten	Church of St. George

Sail / Anchor: Sail to Primošten, anchoring in front of the old town or berthing in Marina Kremik, depending on availability.

What to do: Walk through the historic peninsula and climb to the Church of St. George for one of the most photogenic viewpoints in Dalmatia.

Swim: Swim at Mala Raduča Beach.

Dinner: Konoba *Mediteran* – known for local wines and traditional Dalmatian dishes.

DAY 5	WEDNESDAY	ŠIBENIK
Catedral of St. James	Minerska Bay	Zablaće




Sail / Anchor: Continue north into the Šibenik archipelago, anchoring in *Minerska Bay* or near *Zablaće*.

What to do: Take a taxi boat or dinghy to Šibenik Old Town. Explore the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St. James, medieval streets, and impressive fortresses overlooking the sea.

Dinner: Pelegrini (fine dining) or Konoba Nostalgija for a more relaxed, local atmosphere.


DAY 6	THURSDAY	ZLARIN
St. Nikola	Coral museum	Zlarin



Swim stop: Sail to island Zlarin and enjoy a swim at Zlarin beach. Zlarin is famous for its corals. Coral harvesting is an activity for which Zlarin is renowned and it represents the island's most significant cultural heritage.

Overnight/Dinner: Anchor at Grabaštica and stay overnight. Enjoy your dinner at restaurant *Roko Grebastica Extra Virgin Olive Oil Tasting & Restaurant* or *Mali Lovre* or *HOBA bistro*.

DAY 7	FRIDAY	DRVENIK VELIKI
Uvala Solinska	Blue Lagoon	Marina Baotić



SwimYour paragraph text: Sail to *Uvala Solinska* – crystal-clear shallow waters for relaxing and snorkeling or visiting *Blue Lagoon*.

Lunch: Onboard light lunch.

Afternoon: Return to the marina Baotić between 17h and 18h.

Cultural: Last stroll on the Trogir Riva and old city.

Dinner: Dinner at one of the best restaurants in Trogir *Il Ponte*.
